Political Science**, provided that the candidate must have passed in 5(Five) recognized subjects including at least one language subject with at least 45% marks in aggregate or 50% marks in subjects or related subjects in the qualifying examination. Candidates from vocational background are not eligible to apply in this course.

Candidates passing Higher Secondary Examination conducted by West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or any other equivalent board/council (List of the board/councils are listed below) in the year (2021/2022/2023/2024) are eligible for apply for Honours course in Anthropology, Zoology and Botany. However, if a prospective applicant desires to apply in Zoology (Hons.) or Botany (Hons.), he/she must have to have both Biology and Chemistry in 10+2 level. The candidate must have passed in 5 (Five) recognized subjects including at least one language subject with at least 45% marks in aggregate or 50% marks in subjects or related subjects in the qualifying examination. Candidates from vocational background are not eligible to apply in this course.

Candidates from vocational background are eligible to apply in this course.

Eligibility criteria for admission in B Sc Multidisciplinary Programme in Life Sciences

Candidates passing Higher Secondary Examination conducted by West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or any other equivalent Board/Council (List of the Board/Councils are listed below) in the year (2021/2022/2023/2024) are eligible to apply for B.Sc. General course, provided that the candidate must have passed in 5(Five) recognized subjects including at least one language subject. Candidates from vocational background are not eligible to apply in this course.

All candidates are requested to apply for one or more courses according to their preference and aptitude. Mere compliance of the minimum criteria does not assure admission because the number of seats available for admission is limited and fixed. Merit list will be recognized as the criteria for admission. Further, candidates with formal online application record will only be considered in the merit list. Further, a candidate is not allowed to take admission in multiple course/subject in this college at the same time. If a candidate wishes to take admission in any other course/subject in this college after getting admitted in any other course/subject, he/she has to first cancel his/her admission in the course/subject where he/she has already got admitted.

Note:

Admission to any course under this College is not complete unless and until a candidate is registered under the Vidyasagar University through this College. Any suppression of facts, false statements, if revealed in future will lead to the cancelation of admission.

In order to eradicate it, Hon'ble Supreme Court in Civil Appeal No. 887 of 2009, passed the judgement wherein guidelines were issued for setting up of a Central Crisis Hotline and Anti-Ragging database. In accordance with the orders, UGC (University Grants Commission), Govt. of India has developed a web portal www.antiragging.in.

Ragging is totally prohibited in our institution, and anyone found guilty of ragging and/or abetting ragging, whether actively or passively, or being a part of a conspiracy to promote ragging, is liable to be punished in accordance with the Regulations of UGC as well as under the provisions of any penal law for the time being in force.




It is further to note that only those students who complete the "**Anti-Ragging Affidavit**" via online shall be eligible for the registration under VU.




